## THE CHINESE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG

#### CUHK and CUHK(SZ) Collaborative Double Major Programme (CDMP) University Core Requirements

#### Applicable to CDMP Students w.e.f. 2024-25

Students enrolled for the Collaborative Double Major Programme (CDMP) have to fulfill the University Core Requirements of their home campus. To facilitate students to fulfill the University Core Requirements of their home campus when they are studying on the host campus, the following arrangements are made:

#### Chinese Language (Note 1)

- CUHK students of CDMP may take CHI1000 *Chinese* offered by CUHK(SZ) to fulfill the requirement of CHLT1001 *University Chinese I*. But they have to take another 2-unit course recognized by the Department of Chinese Language and Literature, instead of CHLT1002 *University Chinese II*, in order to satisfy the remaining 2-unit Chinese language requirements.
- CUHK(SZ) students of CDMP have to take CHI1000 *Chinese* offered by CUHK(SZ) to fulfill the Chinese language requirement of CUHK(SZ).
- The following courses offered by CUHK and CUHK(SZ), respectively, are substitute/equivalent/alternative courses:

# **General Education (GE)** (Notes 4 and 5)

- The two GE Foundation courses, *In Dialogue with Humanity* and *In Dialogue with Nature*, offered by CUHK and CUHK(SZ) are two pairs of substitute/equivalent/alternative courses.
- Courses in Area A offered by CUHK can be recognized as courses in Area B, C or D as prescribed by CUHK(SZ), but not vice versa. CUHK(SZ) students of CDMP have to take Area A course offered by their home campus.

- GEA2000 *Modern Chinese History and Culture* offered by CUHK(SZ) is a/an substitute/equivalent/alternative course for a course in Area C offered by CUHK.
- Courses in Area B offered by CUHK and courses in Area B offered by CUHK(SZ) are substitute/equivalent/alternative courses.
- Courses in Area C offered by CUHK and courses in Area C offered by CUHK(SZ) are substitute/equivalent/alternative courses.
- GEC2109 *Tradition and Transformation in Chinese History* offered by CUHK(SZ) is a/an substitute/equivalent/alternative course for a course in Area A or C offered by CUHK; CUHK students of CDMP can choose to fulfill one of the two Areas upon successful completion of the course.
- Courses in Area D offered by CUHK and courses in Area D offered by CUHK(SZ) are substitute/equivalent/alternative courses.
- GED2123 *History of Chinese Philosophy* offered by CUHK(SZ) is a/an substitute/equivalent/alternative course for a course in Area A or D offered by CUHK; CUHK students of CDMP can choose to fulfill one of the two Areas upon successful completion of the course.

## **Physical Education**

The required PE courses offered by CUHK and CUHK(SZ) are substitute/equivalent/alternative courses (1 unit for each course).

## Notes

- 1. Students who are exempted by the Senate from the Chinese language requirements for admission will be assessed and recommended by the Department of Chinese Language and Literature to take suitable Chinese language course(s) to fulfill the University Core Chinese language Requirements. These Putonghua courses offered by the Yale–China Chinese Language Academy may be recommended for international students.
- 2. Students should observe the exemption policy of their home-campus to take the appropriate English courses.
- 3. Students who have taken ELTU1002 are not eligible to take ENG2001. CUHK(SZ) students of CDMP are recommended to take ELTU1001 instead of ELTU1002.
- 4. The substitute/equivalence/alternative courses of the Areas of GE are subject to programme and course exclusions set for serving the broadening purpose of GE.
- 5. Four-Area courses offered by CUHK consist of 2-unit and 3-unit courses, while those offered by CUHK(SZ) all carry 3 units. CUHK(SZ) students of CDMP have to take 3-unit Four-Area courses offered by CUHK if they wish to have these courses counted towards fulfillment of the respective Area requirements of their home campus.
